


PRELIMINARY ROUND

GUIDELINES:

- Follows a buzzer round format.
- Each team should consist of two students from the same institution.
- For students of Classes IX & above.
- The event will consist of three rounds.
- The teams can discuss among themselves and then press the buzzer to answer the question first. No discussion is allowed after pressing the buzzer.
- The team that presses the buzzer first gets a chance to answer it.
- Participants thereby should adhere to the rules and regulations.
- For School Registration, minimum enrollment of one team is necessary.
