Please Read the Instructions Carefully Before Submitting the Form.

Sacred Heart Sr. Sec. School is an all girls' Private Unaided Christian Minority Educational Institution. As such the norms of minority institutions are applicable in the admission process. The school imparts education to the Christian community around and extends its services to the members of the other communities to the extent possible.

Application forms will be available from 15th December, 2025 to 27th December, 2025 on the school website – www.sacredheartchd.com

Duly filled Application forms have to be submitted on <u>09th January</u>, <u>2026 at the school between 12:30pm to 2:30pm and 10th January</u>, <u>2026 at the school between 08:30am to 11:30am</u>

<u>Kindly Note</u>: Forms will not be available at the school. There are FIVE pages in the form. The complete form must be downloaded, duly filled and submitted in the school along with the payment.

ELIGIBILITY:

Only Girl child born between 01st April, 2022 and 31st March, 2023 are eligible.

Applicants residing within nearby areas of Sacred Heart Senior Sec School (Conditions apply)

Police verification of the address of applicant is **COMPULSORY**

Duly filled <u>completed</u> application forms along with photocopies attested by a gazetted officer or by a 1st class magistrate (The attestation must not be more than 6 months old) of relevant documents are to be **deposited**. **Submission** of forms will not be permitted after <u>09th and 10th January, 2026</u> under any circumstances.

<u>Preference will be given to applicants staying in nearby areas(of Sacred Heart Senior Secondary School)</u>, Christians, Siblings, Wards of Alumni, Management and Wards of Staff(Conditions apply)

Kindly Note: Preference does not guarantee admission.

With the firm belief that children should not be exposed to the stress of long journeys, parents are advised to opt for neighbourhood schools.

The school is not responsible for providing transport facilities. There are, however, a few private contractors plying buses, under contract with the school. The buses are being run on pre-designated routes. The routes on which the buses are plying are available on the school website. Parents are therefore advised to apply to neighbourhood schools. Please note that parents will be responsible for arranging transportation for their child if no seat is available on the buses or the child stays outside the already designated routes.

Please Note: NO REQUESTS FOR NEW ROUTES/CHANGE IN ROUTES WILL BE ENTERTAINED.

Please Note: Parents using other means of transport barring the buses which are currently on contract with the school, will be responsible for making safe arrangements of transportation for their children. This includes verification of drivers of the vehicle and all other requirements as directed by the CCPCR, CBSE, Central Government and Administration, Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court etc. Parents are therefore advised to take admission in school near their residence.

The school has already implemented numerous safety and security measures which are detailed on the school website http://www.sacredheartchd.com. Parents are requested to please go through the safety and security measures and apply only after they are satisfied with the measures in place. No objection to the measures will be entertained once a child has been admitted into the school.

Please note that at the time of admission and at all times thereafter, the medical details and record of the child shall be disclosed to the school keeping in the best interest and welfare of the child. Any previous medical history/any other information pertaining to the child's physical, emotional and mental health must be disclosed. Please note: Parents are requested to disclose all information as they may be vital in case of an emergency and in the handling of your child. Parents will be expected to submit an undertaking to the effect that no medical issue is being withheld from the school.

SC Judgement: The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has held in the case of Society for Unaided Private Schools of Rajasthan v/s U.O.I & others Writ Petition © No. 95 of 2010, that the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 (RTE) shall not apply to Unaided Minority Educational Institutions. The National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, Government of India, New Delhi has declared Sacred Heart Sr. Sec. School to be a Minority Educational Institution

within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the NCMEI Act. Therefore being a certified Christian Minority, Unaided Educational Institution, Sacred Heart Sr. Sec. School does not have to reserve 25% seats for the E.D.G. (Economically Disadvantaged Group) as mandated in the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009.

Being a Christian Minority Educational Institution and in imitation of Jesus, who made a preferential option for the poorest of the poor of society, the school has independently been educating children from the E.D.G.(Economically Disadvantaged Group) since 1986 and currently has around 500 students from this category in the school.

Only ONE application form per child is to be submitted. In the event of it being discovered that more than one application has been submitted for a child, all such forms will stand rejected and the candidate shall be disqualified and not be considered for the Draw of Lots.

At the time of submission of forms:

- a) At the time of submission of forms, a sum of Rs. 150/-(non refundable) is to be deposited with each form.
- b) There will be a preliminary examination of the forms. All forms found incomplete/with documents missing/unattested/with incorrect information/ineligible will be rejected.
- c) The accepted forms will, thereafter, be subjected to further detailed scrutiny after which the final list for eligible candidates for the draw of lots will be drawn up.

The Final list of eligible candidates for the draw of lots will be put up on 16th January, 2026 (Friday) outside the school.

Draw of lots will be conducted in the school premises on 19th January 2026 (Monday) at 3:00 pm

1) Birth certificate:

Birth certificate of the child issued in accordance with the provisions of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act,1969 with the Child's Name and Parents' names on it. Please Note: The parents' names must <u>match</u> with the names on applying child's Date of Birth Certificate. No alteration will be permitted in any of the names once the same has been submitted. Hence you are strongly advised, if you so desire, that the necessary rectifications like addition/deletion of the name/surname/parent's name/s is done legally from the Issuing Authority before submitting the Registration Form.

 - (ii) A letter from the respective Parish Priest/Pastor testifying to the membership of their parish and their active involvement in the church.
- 4) Alumni (both):
 - (i) School Leaving Certificate/ Class 10 Pass Certificate.
 - (ii) List detailing the support given to School
- 5) <u>Sibling in school</u>: Birth certificate of sibling with parents' names clearly indicated. Please Note: The parents' names in the sibling's DOB certificate must matchexactly with the names on the applying child's Date of Birth Certificate. No due certificate of the sibling(s) to be attached. (Kindly collect the certificate from the school office)
- 6) Single parents: Suitable supporting documentation indicating legal custody of the child by the applicant.

- 10) Children who are differently abledand can be mainstreamed:
- (i) The learning Disability Certificate issued by the certifying authority designated under sub-section1, section 57 of the Rights ofPersons with Disabilities Act 2016. The certificate must clearly state the nature and percentage of disability.
 - (ii) Detailed assessment report indicating that the child can be mainstreamed.
- 11) Schedule Caste / Schedule Tribe/ Other Backward Class:

- (i) Schedule Caste: SC Certificate of the Child issued by the appropriate authority.
- (ii) Schedule Tribe:ST Certificate of the Child issued by the appropriate authority.
- (iii) Other Backward Class: OBC Certificate of the Child issued by the appropriate authority.
- 12) Documents issued by the government displaying each parents'/Legal Guardian's Signatures.
- 13) "Certificate of Proof of Income" (below Rs 2 Lakh per annum) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (D.C.), Chandigarh.

This certificate should certify the income as total family income(both father and mother of the applicant).
